Liste Showtime: First edition of new online format to run from 14 – 20 September 2020

We are pleased to announce the first edition of Liste's new online format, Liste Showtime, which will run from 10am CEST on Monday, 14 September until 8pm CEST on Sunday, 20 September, with VIP preview days from 11 – 13 September. On the digital platform, 72 galleries from 35 countries will each present one artist who is an outstanding representative of their generation, collectively showcasing the latest developments and trends in contemporary art.

The concept behind Liste Showtime follows in the footsteps of Liste's primary concern, which is to present new artistic positions in great depth year after year. As such, each gallery will showcase one artist and will be able to individualize and independently design their online presentations through the use of various modules and media. Visitors to Liste Showtime will be able to select specific galleries and artists as well as allow themselves to drift through the presentations and discover artists by chance.

Liste Showtime will welcome 19 new galleries who have never participated at Liste Art Fair Basel: Capsule, Shanghai; Central, São Paulo; Crisis, Lima; Drei, Cologne; Eugster || Belgrade, Belgrade; Exo Exo, Paris; Fanta-MLN, Milan; Kai Matsumiya, New York; Nova Contemporary, Bangkok; Osnova, Moscow; Project Fulfill, Taipei; Sans titre (2016), Paris; Selma Feriani, Tunis; Shore, Vienna; Sophie Tappeiner, Vienna; Sundry, London; Tabula Rasa, Beijing; Vanguard, Shanghai; and Wschód, Warsaw.

Poster project: "Rewriting Our Imaginations"

In addition to the digital platform for galleries, Liste Showtime also encompasses a poster project titled "Rewriting Our Imaginations", which was inspired by an essay written by science-fiction author Kim Stanley Robinson for *The New Yorker* magazine

and was created in collaboration with artists selected by the participating galleries. For the project, each selected artist designed a poster at a time when life as we knew it was disrupted and what had previously existed only in imaginations became reality; thus, "Rewriting Our Imaginations" asks what new imaginations and new futures might look like when what was previously fictional is transformed into something real.

While posing questions about shifting imaginations and realities, the project is also about exploring new modes of production, presentation and distribution that are independent of physical travel and shipment. Thus, the posters will be showcased on Liste Showtime in our new online shop and can be purchased as PDFs for CHF 30 each. Buyers can then print the files in their preferred size and with their preferred technique. The original works can also be requested and purchased directly from the galleries.

Furthermore, there is the possibility to develop "Rewriting Our Imaginations" into an exhibition series that can easily be shown anywhere around the world, as the PDFs can be sent digitally and produced on site as posters. The series will begin in Basel, where the posters will be displayed on public billboards throughout the city from 2 – 15 September.

We would like to thank all of the participating artists and galleries for their commitment and their visions, without which this experiment would not have been possible. The complete list of artists featured in "Rewriting Our Imaginations" can be found at the end of this media release.

Notes to editors

About Liste

Liste Art Fair Basel was founded in 1996 by Zurich gallerists Eva Presenhuber and Peter Kilchmann together with the curator Peter Bläuer. The first edition featured 37 galleries from 12 countries, including Air de Paris, Paris; Massimo di Carlo, Milan; Peter Kilchmann, Zurich; Urs Meile, Lucerne; neugerriemschneider, Berlin; Maureen Paley, London; Martin Janda, Vienna; Eva Presenhuber, Zurich; Barbara Weiss, Berlin; and David Zwirner, New York.

Since 2019, Liste has been under the direction of Joanna Kamm, who works to maintain the fair's central concern: opening the door to the international art world for a new generation of gallerists and artists. Liste's unique location is a former brewery, which has housed the Werkraum Warteck pp since the 1990s. From Liste's inaugural edition through today, Warteckpp's tenants have vacated their studios, offices, and workshops and handed them over to our participating galleries for the week of the fair. However, due to COVID-19, the 25th edition of Liste in 2020 had to be cancelled. In its place will be the first edition of the new online format, Liste Showtime, which will run from 14 – 20 September 2020.
