A total of 60 solo and 20 group presentations will be on show, as well as one collective stand. The artists presented are outstanding representatives of their generation and represent the latest developments and trends in contemporary art.

Painter Mariel Capanna (Adams and Ollman, Portland) and Japanese artist Masaya Chiba (Bel Ami, Los Angeles), among others, explore the subtle relationships between memory, place and perception through performative, reflexive painting while exploring the boundaries of visual representation and translation.

The soft and malleable sculptures of <u>Eva Fàbregas</u> (<u>Bombon</u>, Barcelona) embrace the possibility of tactile touch, bodily intimacy, affective bonding and various forms of somatic experimentation with and through objects. <u>Nevine Mahmoud</u> (<u>Soft Opening</u>, London) literally objectifies bodily attributes by making the fragmented body her own, while <u>Zuza Golińska's</u> (<u>Piktogram</u>, Warsaw) installation of steel and satin is meant to be seen as a reference to the oppression against the female, gender-atypical or gay body.

The presentation "Mine Your Own Business" by <u>Gabrielle Torres-Ferrer</u> (<u>Embajada</u>, San Juan), among others, responds to concrete social and political developments by critically examining the current digital environment. <u>Empty Gallery</u> from Hong Kong will showcase paintings by artist <u>Xper.Xr</u> created in the wake of the 2019 protests, COVID-19 restrictions and political unrest, while <u>Andre Morgan's</u> installation at <u>Harlesden High Street</u> (London) will explore themes of identity, particularly the diverse cultural backgrounds of the working class, gentrification and political ecology, and aims to celebrate Juneteenth National Independence Day. On the last day of the fair, 19 June 2022, Morgan will host a special celebration. Detailed information can be found <u>here</u>.

Xu <u>Zhan Zhang's</u> stop-motion animation videos (<u>Project Fulfill</u>, Taipei) trace his family's traditional Taiwanese paper craft and his interest in developing cultural beliefs. His work reflects the universality and at the same time the mutability of our cultural vessels.

The relationship between the natural and the artificial, faith and science, is explored by <u>Tomás Díaz Cedeño</u> (<u>Peana</u>, Monterrey) and Kelvin Kyung Kun Park (Vanguard, Shanghai), among others. <u>Kyung Kun Park's</u> work "When Tigers Used to Smoke" (2021) shows digitally edited videos of wild animals taken at the local zoo, conveying loneliness and alienation.

Liste is particularly looking forward to welcoming new special guests this year: I Never Read with their bookshop project; the artists Jeronim Horvat, Maya Hottarek and Lukas Stäuble with their bar Lucky Barn, which they designed and run; and the Pejman Foundation with an installation by Neda Saeedi and Jason Mohaghegh & Asad Khan. Long-standing special guests Helvetia Art Prize and HEK will be showing works by Anita Mucolli (the 2021 Helvetia Art Prize winner) and Eva Papamargariti, respectively.

Lucky Barn by Jeronim Horvat, Maya Hottarek and Lukas Stäuble

The Lucky Barn is a bar(n) dreamed up, planned and run by the artists Jeronim Horvat, Maya Hottarek and Lukas Stäuble, offering soft drinks, a video programme and a mobile phone charging station. It will be located in front of the entrance to the exhibition hall. One night Jeronim Horvat dreamt that Maya Hottarek showed a sculpture in an exhibition that resembled a horse stable, but it was made of plastic and there was a monitor on the back wall showing slow-motion videos of horses galloping in the wild. The director of Liste, Joanna Kamm, found this dream sculpture very appropriate for an artists' bar, and the dream will now become reality thanks to the Lucky Barn, which will be open throughout the fair.

Pejman Foundation shows Neda Saeedi and Jason Mohaghegh & Asad Khan

The Pejman Foundation, based in Tehran, comprises a contemporary art museum (Argo Factory), a residency programme (Kandovan) and a wide range of art programmes, including temporary exhibitions, publications and educational initiatives. At Liste Art Fair Basel the foundation will present sculptural works by Neda Saeedis that explore the relationship between humans, architecture and the environment, as well as the value, materiality, power and ownership of the (human and non-human) body in relation to urban development projects. Juxtaposing this will be works by Jason Mohaghegh & Asad Khan, who often engage in technological investigations and speculative explorations of worlds that may never exist. Here, the duo will consciously enter into a dialogue with Saeedi's work.

Helvetia Art Prize shows 2021 award-winner Anita Mucolli

Helvetia Insurance is participating in Liste Art Fair Basel for the 19th time with the Helvetia Art Prize, which supports young artists at the beginning of their professional careers. In a variety of media and with formal precision, Anita Mucolli, a graduate of the School of Art and Design FHNW in Basel, deals with the question of how late capitalist systems try to penetrate the biology of humankind and our needs. In her most recent work, "The Bank Of Dreams" (2021), she deals with a future scenario in which capitalism makes the progress of technology its own, penetrates people's subconscious and commercialises sleep and dreams.

HEK shows Eva Papamargariti

The House of Electronic Arts (HEK) Basel is a museum dedicated to digital culture and new art forms of the information age. This year, it will present a site-specific installation by Eva Papamargariti at Liste. The Greek artist's work defies classification and not only moves between different genres but combines them. Her creations appear both figurative and abstract, organic and inorganic, depicting landscapes and uncanny creatures that seem to remain in a state of suspended animation.

Initiatives in support of Ukraine

As a sign of solidarity and against Russia's inhumane invasion of Ukraine, galleries, curators and the Liste team have launched projects to support Ukrainians and the country's art scene in particular. More than three months into the war, Liste believes it is more important than ever to give visibility to people who no longer have the opportunity to exhibit in their own country.

Fair participation by The Naked Room and Voloshyn (both from Kyiv)

This year, Liste has specially invited two Ukrainian galleries to exhibit at the fair, The Naked Room and Voloshyn, to give them the opportunity to present their artists internationally while war is raging in their country.

The Naked Room, a contemporary art gallery from Kyiv, was founded in 2018 by curators Lizaveta German and Maria Lanko and Swiss film director Marc Wilkins. The gallery focuses on creating an art market for younger Ukrainian artists. German and Lanko are the curators of the Ukrainian Pavilion at the 59th Venice Biennale this year. At Liste they will show the artists Katya Buchatska (*1987 in Kyiv), Lucy Ivanova (*1989 in Dnipro) and Kateryna Lysovenko (*1989 in Kyiv). While Buchatska's artistic methodology lies in her passion for extra-human life forms and experiences, in errors of perception or the deconstruction of a medium, Ivanova uses the traditional medium of painting to transfer everyday situations into a mysterious, post-medial state. More...

With the presentation of the three Ukrainian artists Nikita Kadan, Lesia Khomenko and Mykola Ridnyi, the Kyiv-based gallery Voloshyn will draw attention to how artists reflect on historical events and processes and how their works find new relevance in another historical moment through the passage of time. Drawings by Kadan were made during the war in Ukraine that reflect the realities of the war he witnessed, while Ridnyi's sculptures from the series "More Flags" explore recent changes in the perception of national symbols in Ukraine, where the ubiquitous national flags and symbols have acquired a special political and historical significance. Drawing on her academic training in post-socialist realism, Khomenko's work investigates the possibility of painting becoming once again political again in today's context. In her recent projects, she deconstructs not only the painting but also all the components of the painting, its material supports. More...

Liste has commissioned curator Martha Kirszenbaum, in collaboration with Oleksandra Pogrebnyak and Daria Shevtsova from PinchukArtCenter, Kyiv, to conceive a film programme within the framework of the fair that presents Ukrainian artists and filmmakers. The programme, whose title quotes a verse by the Ukrainian poet Dmytro Lazutkin, attempts to map and document the Ukrainian cultural and art scenes on the eve of war through 19 film works, paying attention to various practices and aesthetics while unveiling a diversity of viewpoints and personal engagements. Understructure collective at LC Queisser (Tbilisi)

The Georgian gallery LC Queisser is integrating the Ukrainian collective Understructures into its presentation of Sitara Abuzar Ghaznawi and Elene Chantladze at Liste. On this occasion, the collective has created the publication "Oberih", a Ukrainian word which translates to 'amulet' or 'talisman' – an object endowed with special powers to protect against illness and misfortune or to bring good luck, health and special protection to its owner. The book is a collection of personal oberihs and stories of Ukrainians, sharing intimate connections between people, memories and events, conveyed through a symbolic object. The publication will be presented and available to purchase at LC Queisser's stand. All of the proceeds will help support people in Ukraine. More...

Extended presentation with Ukrainian artists at Sandwich and Suprainfinit (both from Bucharest)

Bucharest gallery Sandwich has added artist Natasha Shulte, who explores the lines of tension between state control and personal identities, to their presentation at Liste. The gallery Suprainfinit, also from Bucharest, will show works by Darya Koltsova in addition to their solo presentation of mountaincutters. Koltsova explores the personal versus the social and the need to create new aesthetic codes for the collective consciousness.

Friends of Liste

Friends of Liste is supporting nine galleries that distinguish themselves with particularly committed stand presentations this year. In addition, the two Ukrainian galleries The Naked Room and Voloshyn, as well as the Eastern European galleries LC Queisser, Suprainfinit and Sandwich, which will exhibit Ukrainian artists, have been awarded joint funding by Friends of Liste, the Eckenstein-Geigy Foundation and the Foundation for the Promotion of Contemporary Art Basel. Furthermore, artists from 29 galleries are being supported by the Eckenstein-Geigy Foundation and the Foundation for the Promotion of Contemporary Art Basel with grants for production costs in order to create the best possible conditions for first-class presentations.

This extraordinary fair architecture is characterised by directness and simplicity, and it is only possible because Liste Art Fair Basel, as a non-profit, does not charge participation fees based on square-meters but rather charges flat rates according to a scaled pricing system based on solidarity. The open areas created inside and outside the circle will be used this year for special guest projects, gastronomy and magazine stands.
